The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Thanthai Periyar Government Institute of Technology (TPGIT), Vellore, consists of **100 active volunteers** in each unit who regularly participate in various community service and social welfare activities.

One of the major activities organized by the NSS unit was the **Swachh Bharat Awareness and Cleanliness Programme**, jointly conducted by TPGIT and the Municipal Corporation. The programme was coordinated by **Prof. M. Kantha Shoba, M.E., Assistant Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering**, and **Prof. M.
