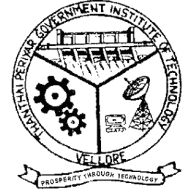




## THANTHAI PERIYAR GOVERNMENT INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, VELLORE-632 002.
